

Hungerford 2036 – Resources

Purpose of this document is to advise Team Members what resources are available to the H2036 project and what constraints if any apply.

Financial

HTC have made an allocation of £5000 to support the project in 2018/19. Further funding may be possible.

Government money up to £17,000 is also available to fund –

- Printing, design of engagement and promotional materials
- Room hire
- Buying in consultancy support
- Developing a neighbourhood plan website
- Plus many more activities.....but not those given below!

But this government money must not fund any of the following:

- General administration costs, including taking minutes at steering group meetings
- Funding salaried posts
- Paying for volunteer time (but can be used to cover expenses)
- Any activities that have started or have already been completed
- Capital items (e.g. printers, computers)
- Work associated with activities outside the remit of neighbourhood planning (e.g. many transport issues can't be dealt with through a neighbourhood plan).

Application for funding needs to be made via *Locality* <https://neighbourhoodplanning.org/>

The National Lottery has been reported as being prepared to fund some NDP activities.

Free Consultancy Advice

Locality also provide free advice on the following:

- Housing needs assessment
- Site options and assessment
- Environmental impact assessment
- Evidence base and policy assessment
- Strategic environmental assessment
- Master planning
- Design including design codes
- Habitats regulation assessment
- Plan health check.
