Meetings

One Project Team (PT) meetings was held on 13th February.

Main Work Activities

A finalized set of Aims and Objectives for *Hungerford 2036* for public consultation have now been published on Hungerford2036.info . The Team is now identifying and arranging opportunities to consult with the community as widely as possible.

A telephone conference call was held with AECOM consultancy who are producing a “Housing Needs Assessment” using a standardized method to statistically estimate the Plan area’s likely demand for dwellings up to 2036. A final report from AECOM is expected shortly.

Attending joint liaison meeting with HTC and WBC re Hungerford Station future ideas / plans and transport modeling.

Identifying and sourcing information to underpin the aims and objectives themes.

Engagement with Hungerford Community

The next stage of consultation is underway and will continue through to the spring.

Consultation will be centered on the draft Aims and Objectives to test their accuracy, adequacy and the level of community support for them.

The H2036 web site is updated regularly with reports to HTC and minutes of meetings.
